EMILY-SARAH BOLDEMAN

"My great-aunt died in a house fire in the 1950s. She had locked herself in and couldn't escape the blaze. She was unmarried and 'a difficult woman'. As a child I inferred from this story that promiscuity and disorganisation caused her grisly death. I imagined her scratching at the door, a mythical addition to the cast of tragic fairy-tale princesses that occupied my imagination. Women or girls whose feet are singed or amputated in punishment. Women trapped in fiery shoes, forced to dance to death. As an adult, my rapt horror and fascination remain equal."

Ballet, saturated with femininity, beauty and pain, is an apt and recurrent motif in Boldeman's work.

Pointe shoes spontaneously combust or are transformed through an alchemical process into fragile, cindery charcoal.

Boldeman's emotionally-charged drawings are enacted to music and bound by a predetermined time frame, much like a ballet performance.

The scale of her body, and limits of physical reach inform her large works, where she lunges, pivots and dances across the paper.

In these works the artist defies the patriarchal constraints of ballet and reclaims her physical expression as an act of empowerment and beauty.

Her exhibition *Vestiges* celebrates the disorganised female body, chaos and transformation.
