There will be covered and uncovered areas for artists to work outdoors on the western side of the building – overlooking the Tweed River and towards Mount Warning/Wollumbin. Note that there will be public interaction, so please be prepared to share your experience and 'spruik' your work. Sales and commissions are all possible! What to bring

We ask that artists joining the Artist Paint Out endeavor to be as self-sufficient as possible with materials and equipment:

- Hat/ sunscreen/ insect repellent/ drink bottle
- Portable easel/ folding table / drawing board with clips
- Portable stool/ cushion or rug to sit on
- Paper/ sketchbooks/ stretched canvases
- Brushes
- Containers for water/other access to clean water will be provided
- Paints/ pencils/ pastels/ charcoal/ inks or any other preferred art materials
- Rags/ paper towel

Note that the Gallery will have a limited quantity of the following available for use and it will be 'first in best-dressed':

- Portable stools
- Large portable easels
- Portable desk easels
- · Containers for water

There will be some access to the Frances Mills Education Workshop for water replenishing and clean up opportunities.
