In Modern Beloved artist Rosi Griffin explores the vastly changing urban landscape in Australia and the loss of architectural gems which seem to fall between the cracks. Griffin puts the viewer in touch with Gold Coast's mid-century architecture and raises much needed awareness of Queensland's rapidly disappearing postwar buildings.

Modernist architecture was a big breakthrough in the way people lived through the use of better building materials, open interior floor plans, flat or low pitch roofs and the extensive use of glass to bring in natural light.

Griffin raises the question about the importance of heritage which creates a sense of stability and permanence in our society. She believes the iconic modernist homes built after the 1950s are an important part of our neighbourhoods and worth preserving for future generations. The Gold Coast is thought of as a young city without a great deal of history but a colourful retro aesthetic still exists and highlights the contrast between mass production and unique architecture.

In this exhibition Griffin has captured rare architectural gems which are sometimes tucked away and their discoveries can only be made by walking the streets. Her work is part of a documentation of our built environment.

Getting outside walking is good for the soul and provides me with endless inspiration for my work. It's about bringing the outside in. The built urban environment with the main emphasis on the domestic home is the focus of my work. My goal is to capture those vulnerable structures in danger of disappearing due to a lack of appreciation and economic reasons. In this body of work, I pay homage to Gold Coast's post war modern architecture. In recent years I have re-discovered my love of watercolour painting and found it very suitable for this kind of work. The inspiration came from illustrations in a Taubman's Paint catalogue from the 1950's.

During my walks I have come across many different Breeze Block patterns, which I have explored in various mediums. The production of laser cut Perspex panels was a new way of exploring this topic for me. The use of fluorescent and mirror Perspex has opened new possibilities for future work.






















Pink Clover 2022 lasercut Perspex 30 x 30 x 30cm \$900




Lotus Breeze I 2022 lasercut Perspex 60 x 60 x 8cm \$1,500








