

VESSEL Linda Kruger "When I first contemplated this exhibition just over a year ago, I'd already developed what has turned out to be an enduring interest in painting very simple pared-back vessel forms - vases, bottles, cups, bowls - arranged together according to character, shape or palette.

Over time the work has developed to include different contexts: flowers have transformed bottles into vases, tabletops and stools have become vessel pedestals. I've explored increasingly more complex arrangements and – encouraged by the opportunity to exhibit here – begun to experiment with loosening my gestures, and painting on a larger scale.

I hope visitors will find something here that strikes a personal chord, and that they find pleasure in the moment of recognition."








